### **Chepstow and District Debt Charity Says:**

### "We Wish You A Priceless Christmas"

A LOCAL debt charity has released its own top tips for staying in the black over the festive season.

Churches Together in Chepstow & District, who run a debt counselling service in conjunction with national charity Christians Against Poverty (CAP), has launched a list of tried-and-tested ways to avoid festive financial meltdown.

Isobel Mead, Chepstow & District Debt Centre Manager, said: "All the adverts sell us the line that the best kind of Christmas is one that can be bought, which just isn't true; the best Christmases are about making priceless memories, which is why we created the list."

She added that for the last few years the Chepstow & District CAP Debt Centre has seen a spike in the numbers of people coming to them in the months after Christmas.

Isobel Mead said: "The reason for this is either because some people realise they have spent more than they can afford, or they have reached a crisis point in their finances. Various things can trigger this, but most commonly it's job loss, an unexpected illness or relationship breakdown.

"Now is the right time for families to talk to each other about creating a sensible game-plan to ensure that Christmas is happy for everyone"

The top tips have come from both the experience of those within the charity, as well as CAP's own clients who know what it is like to stick to a tight budget as they clear their debts.

- Agree on a game plan to stop all of you overspending: do a 'secret Santa'? Agree on a set amount each? A 'just for the kids' rule? A 'from charity shops only' rule?
- If children have their heart set on something out of your price range, club together with relatives.
- Short of a new Christmas outfit? Get together with mates for a swapping party and you'll all go home with something new, without the cost.
- 4. If you're doing the meal, ask guests to each contribute something: drinks? pudding? cheese? cake? a turkey?! If you're spending



time cooking a Christmas feast, you are already giving a lot.

- Aim to only buy the food you will actually eat and decide what you will do with left-overs eg potato cakes from cooked potatoes, make stock from Turkey carcass, soup from uneaten vegetables, freeze un-used gravy for another time.
- Home-made goodies always go down well cupcakes, chocolate truffles, shortbread, jam – all are cheap to make and, wrapped with cellophane and ribbon, make great presents.
- Your time and thoughtfulness are every bit as valuable as your money. Instead of presents, offer vouchers for gardening, washing the car, a few hours cleaning, ironing or making someone's favourite cake or snack.
- 8. So many people live alone a cheery visit from you is worth more than any present.
- Spend time focusing on what you can enjoy at no cost and make Christmas really special: watching your kids in the school nativity; watching the lights get switched on; enjoying Christmas carols in church; dressing the tree; playing family games.
- Never take out credit or be tempted by a Christmas loan – you don't know what the New Year will bring. Your income may change and it could affect your whole family's security. No Christmas is worth that.

On Saturday 2nd December the Chepstow Rotary Club will stage its annual Torchlight Carol Service at Tintern Abbev.

This popular family event is always well supported and last year over 400 people attended. Thanks to publicity such as this in Chepstow Matters, posters, in-programme advertising and flyers handed out on the High Street, the Club enjoys much local support for this wonderful event.

From 6pm families form a column in front of the Anchor Inn, Tintern holding their flaming torches on high to light their way, while the smaller members carry light-sticks. They will then walk slowly in column around the outside of the Abbey to the wonderful sounds of the choir singing carols within. It is always most satisfying to see the faces of the young, and not so young, reflected in the flames of the torches as they enter the rear of this beautiful and historic building.

Tintern Abbey is certainly an atmospheric location by day. But by night, in floodlight, with hundreds of flaming torches burning brightly and with the sound of carols sung by the choir, it becomes a positively magical place. "Harry Potter has nothing on this", said one visitor!




The closing prayers and blessing was conducted by the new Vicar of Chepstow, Rev Philip Averary.

### **Know Your Rights -**

### **Christmas Shopping**

Christmas can be a busy time and many of us will buy goods in the lead up to Christmas. When you buy goods or services you have certain protection under consumer law and here is a reminder about some of your main rights.

### Your decision to buy

- · All purchases or orders for goods involve Term and Conditions (T&Cs) or the small print. You will be expected to keep to these, even if you haven't read
- You don't have an automatic right to get your money back if you change your mind. Always check the return's policy of the shop or seller.
- · When buying and paying on-line make sure the site is secure and keep copies of the paperwork. You have a 14 day cooling off period should you change your mind, but if you do, you must tell the seller straight

### My goods haven't arrived - what can I do?

- · Contact the seller to find out where the item is. Call or email their customer services.
- The seller should chase the delivery company and let you know what's happened to your item.
- · If the item doesn't turn up, you're legally entitled to a replacement or refund. You can expect a refund within 14 days of the retailer agreeing you're entitled to one.
- It is important to keep a record of all contact with the customer services department and confirm the problem to them in writing (email/text/letter).

### Refunds via the method of payment

- · Debit card contact your bank and say you want to use the chargeback scheme.
- · Credit card contact your credit card company to get the money back.

· PayPal - use PayPal's online resolution centre to report your dispute. You must do this within 180 days.

### Faulty electrical goods - repair, refund or replacement via the seller.

If an electrical item is faulty:

- · don't attempt to fix it yourself this could stop you getting redress because it will be harder to prove you didn't cause the fault
- · return it to the retailer it's the responsibility of the seller to help you resolve the problem, not the manufacturer.

If the item was bought within the last 30 days you can get a refund on a faulty product. If bought within the last 6 months you are entitled to have it repaired once or replaced. If the item still doesn't work you should get a full refund.

### Lost, damaged or delayed post

- · You can claim compensation from Royal Mail if your post was lost, damaged or delayed. You can complain using their on-line form, by phoning their customer services or in writing.
- · If you've had a problem with a delivery or damage from a courier company you should:
- complain to the seller from whom you bought the
- complain directly to the courier if you were using their services to send a parcel and it arrived
- follow the courier company's complaints process - find this on their website, or email or phone their customer services.


