

Morning Nursery Spaces Available

SARA is a volunteer search and rescue charity, with Lifeboat and Rescue Stations along the length of the River Severn. The teams based at Beachley (near Chepstow) and Newport work together, to perform rescues on the Usk, Ebbw and Wye as well as the Severn, and to conduct land search and rescue across Gloucestershire. In 2019 SARA conducted 109 different operations.

This summer, operations have belonged largely to the lifeboat crew. SARA Lifeboat 1 'The Jim Hewitt' had her 100th operational launch at the start of July: a small cruiser making her way down to Bristol from Sharpness had suffered engine failure near Severn Beach. SARA 1 was able to tow her to St Pierre Pill, where she could be safely moored. By coincidence one of our coxswains was out his jetski in the area at the time and was able to assist (and to take photos!).

Not long before that we had had 3 lifeboat callouts in 3 days. Towards the end of a Sunday morning's training session, both Beachley lifeboats were deployed to the mouth of the River Wye. A vessel with 5 persons on board had had engine failure and was taking on water, and her crew had sensibly called the Coastguard. The 'casualty vessel' had restarted the engine and made good the water ingress on arrival of SARA Lifeboat 3. SARA Lifeboat 1 arrived shortly thereafter and put a crew member aboard to monitor her on the passage back to Beachley slip, under escort of both lifeboats.

The next day SARA Lifeboat 1 was launched to support Avon and Somerset Police with an operation on the edge of the River Severn near Aust. The crew stood by close to the area, to assist if required, but ultimately the operation was resolved from the shore. And then the following evening there was a report of a car having driven off the slipway at low water and multiple

emergency services attended. SARA Lifeboat 3 was launched and searched the possible area of low water to Chapel Rock, and crew explored the end of the slip for signs of anything submerged, but couldn't find anything. The crew was stood down after the Coastguard reviewed our CCTV, and ascertained that the vehicle had in fact driven back up and then away, so thankfully this had been a false alarm!

Another false alarm was the launch of SARA 3 to reports of a dinghy in the area between the two motorway bridges, drifting downstream on the outgoing tide. The 'dinghy' turned out to be a large cluster of helium balloons, plus some stragglers. These were all collected and, following a search of the area in case there was something else, handed over to Chepstow Coastguard back at Beachley.

Return to Live Training

Throughout the early stages of 'lockdown', all training ceased, with our efforts being put into maintaining our operability in challenging pandemic times. We maintained our knowledge base and learnt new skills to enable us to use appropriate PPE to keep ourselves, and any casualties we had to deal with, safe using online, video call based training.





With the reduction in infection rates towards the end of June, and after consultation with our local statutory authorities, we were given the go ahead to commence face to face training in a socially distanced, pandemic safe fashion.

Many elements of what we do at SARA have to be practiced in a (sanitised!) hands on fashion, and without practise we would suffer from skill fade, putting ourselves and those we help potentially in jeopardy. Our first priority on returning to training was to put into practice our new policies on Covid PPE, how to take it off in a safe fashion, and carry out our normal tasks in a socially distanced way.

Working in a Covid safe fashion has brought a new challenge in the hot summer months, and a great respect for those on the NHS frontline who have to wear PPE all day long (though heaving a stretcher up a steep hillside is perhaps a different challenge).

Since training recommenced there has been a lot achieved, with many team members gaining qualifications in Sea Survival, RYA Powerboat 2 and Safety Boat, and Rescue 3 Swiftwater Flood Rescue Technician (SRT). On top of this we have revisited our land search, cliff rescue and inshore lifeboat skills

Congratulations to lifeboat helms Jerry and Dave, who passed their RYA Intermediate Powerboat course.

SRT Success

In July, three members of SARA Beachley, as well as eight team members from the new SARA Station at Upton-upon-Severn, qualified or recertified as Rescue 3 Europe Swiftwater and Flood Rescue Technicians ('SRTs'). The course had started in March but was then paused by the pandemic.



When it re-started in June they visited a new venue at Nafford Weir, on the Avon near Upton, with some challenging white water.

The final day of the course saw them in the Wye at Monmouth, searching for and then rescuing two casualties. All casualties had to be treated as Covid-positive at present, with the use of PPE which that entails. The teams also had to organise a landing site for a helicopter, and then swim out to rescue a whole series of logs floating past, since we can't rescue each other at present!

As part of this, it was particularly nice to welcome Glynn Lewis back to SARA. He left SARA in 2015 due to family commitments but kept in touch and will be joining the next land search training intake as well as the SRT team.


They are also ordering several hundred crocuses that will be planted a little later in the year. More on that later.

Lift the pressure of September spending
